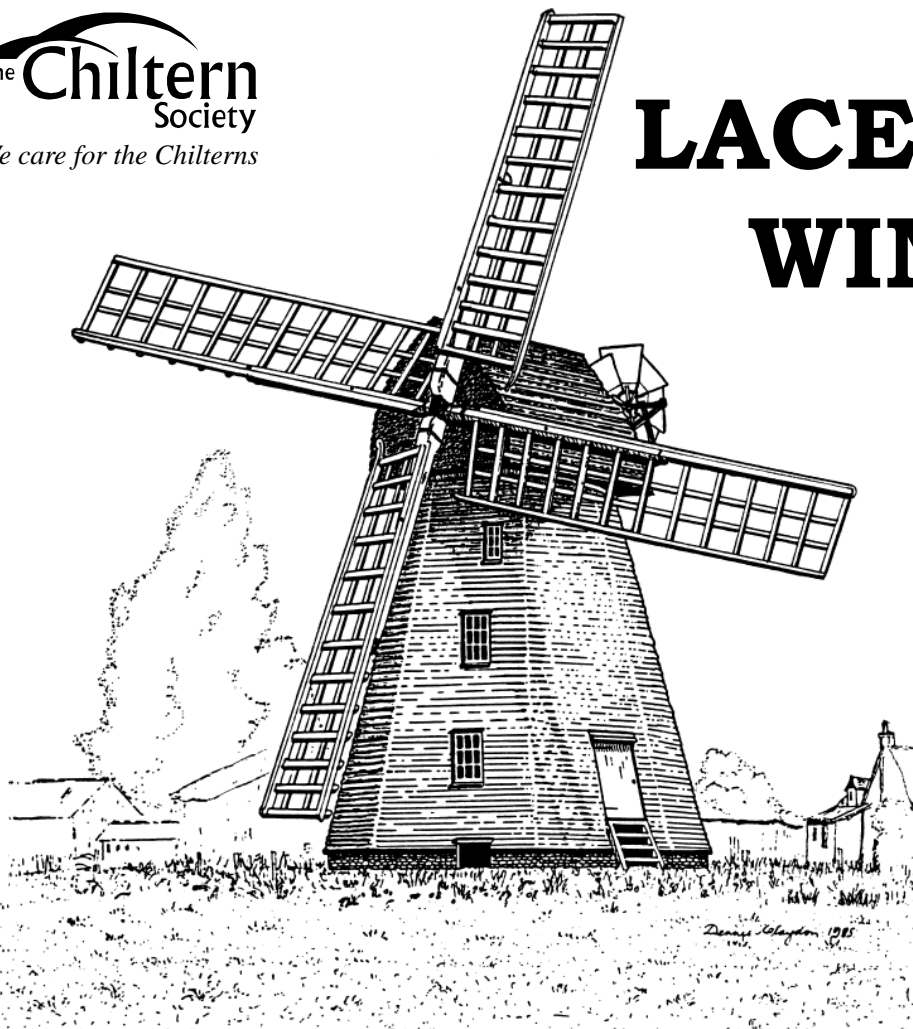

The mill is situated behind 'The Whip' public house.

Please park in Pink Road, and walk up path to mill.

Princes Risborough station is 2 miles away, and buses on route 300 between Aylesbury and High Wycombe stop at 'The Whip'.
